





Green Woodworking Experience Day

Why not come for a one day introduction to the art and craft of green woodworking with experienced green woodworker David Stovell at his outdoor workshop in Halstead, Essex.

Greenwood is unseasoned (wet) wood, and green woodwork is the tradition of working this fresh soft wood with sharp tools to make spoons, bowls, spatulas and many other items for domestic use.

The day will cover:

- An introduction to the basics of greenwood species and selection
- Processing a log with froe and axe.
- Using a shave-horse and other traditional hand tools and techniques.
- After mastering these techniques, you have the choice to try turning an item on the polelathe (a traditional foot powered reciprocating lathe) or making an item of treen for you to use at home.

The day will cover safety and good technique, tool selection, culture and who to look at as examples of great green woodworkers. Lunch and refreshments are included.

The day is run on a one to one basis or in very small groups to allow for intensive instruction.

Due to weather the experience days normally run between March and November, but we can be flexible to meet dates that fit in with you.

And don't worry, previous experience is not necessary.
